MAXIMUM NUMBER OF CONSIGNMENTS TO BE CHECKED BY AN OVS

Purpose

1. To ask <u>all BIPs</u> to complete the **Annex** sent with this note, with up to date information on the maximum number of consignments checked by an OVS.

Background

- 2. OVS Note 2016/24 issued on 30 September 2016 referred to the DG Health Directorate F (Health & Food Audits & Analysis)) audit carried out some time ago which recommended that Defra provides guidance on the maximum number of consignments that a full time OVS should carry out.
- 3. Following a meeting between Defra, BIPs, FSA and OVSs the issue was raised again and it was agreed that a number of other issues e.g. staffing levels at different BIPs with different number of assistants need to be taken into account, and be included in the guidance. A copy of the minutes was sent to you in March this year.
- 4. To ensure that the current guidance reflects current processes, we need more up to date data from <u>all BIPs</u>. Once we have received your returns, an Audit will be carried out based on the data that you provide.

Action for OVSs

5. All BIPs must treat this request as <u>priority</u> and complete the Annex (Word doc) to this OVS note for the year 2016 - 2017.
