I am writing to let you know that Commission Implementing Decision (EU) 2019/525, which further amends the Annex to Commission Decision 2011/163/EU has been issued. The Decision applies from today and can be found here: https://eur-lex.europa.eu/legal-content/EN/TXT/PDF/?uri=CELEX:32019D0525&from=EN. The Decision makes a single change, with the inclusion of the South African plan for farmed game (ratites only).

It is also worth noting that the entry for 'former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia' is now 'North Macedonia', while 'Swaziland' is now 'Eswatini'.
