MAXIMUM NUMBER OF CONSIGNMENTS TO BE CHECKED BY AN OVS

Purpose

1. To request all BCPs to complete the annex attached with up to date information on the weekly number of consignments checked by an OVS.

Background

- 2. OVS Note <u>2018/13</u> issued on 15 August 2018 requested data from all BCPs on the maximum number of consignments checked by an OVS for the review of the relevant guidance. Defra issued a follow up note on 31 October 2018 (<u>2018/17</u>), in which BCPs were advised that the maximum number of consignments a full time (40hr/wk) OVS should check in one year is **2,800**.
- To ensure that this guidance reflects current processes, Defra requests more up to date data from <u>all BCPs</u>. Once Defra has received all returns, a review of the guidance will be carried out.

Actions for OVSs

4. All BCPs must treat this request as a <u>priority</u> and complete the annex attached for the year 2018 - 2019.







5. The completed annex must be returned to the Imports and EU Trade Policy Team ImportsTradeinAnimalsandProducts@defra.gov.uk within three weeks from the date of publication of this OVS note.
