Approved countries for the import of insects

Summary: Thailand has been added to the list of approved countries for the importation of insects.

Dear colleague,

Further to our letter of 11 March (IMPEN20011), I am writing to infom you that an update to Regulation 2019/626 has been published.

Regulation 2020/1572 makes changes to Article 10 (dairy products), Annex IIIa (list of approved countries for insects) and can be seen here: <u>https://eur-lex.europa.eu/legal-content/EN/TXT/PDF/?uri=CELEX:32020R1572&qid=1605187540837&from=EN</u>.

This amendment means that insects are now permitted from Canada, Switzerland, South Korea and Thailand.
