COVID IMPORTS EASEMENTS UPDATE

Purpose

- 1. To advise you that the Covid imports easements statement below have been updated.
- 2. BCPs who are not able to meet normal requirements laid down in Regulation 2017/625 should contact lmported.Food@food.gov.uk for advice.
- 3. Please note that remaining easement enabling electronic document certification remains in place until 1 April 2021. See table below reflecting the easements that have been continued, re-instated and revoked.
