LIFTING OF RESTRICTIONS IN RELATION TO IMPORTS OF POULTRY PRODUCTS FROM JAPAN

Purpose

1. <u>OVS Note 2021/11</u> advised of outbreaks of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI) in Japan.

Background

- 2. Since November 2020, the importation into Great Britain of poultry and poultry products from Japan has been suspended due to outbreaks HPAI.
- 3. In July 2022, the Japanese competent authority supplied information to Defra about the epidemiological situation and the measures taken to control the outbreaks. A risk assessment has concluded that the importation of certain poultry products from Japan can resume.
- 4. The list of countries <u>approved</u> for the importation of fresh poultry meat and poultry meat products has been update accordingly to reflect the following:
 - **Poultry and poultry products -** In row for Japan with 'POU' in column 4, inserted opening date "13/08/2022" in column 6B
 - **Meat products -** In table 2, in row for Japan, changed from 'D' to 'A' in column 7.
