

# Do you keep pigs, even just as pets...?

## Help to reduce the risk of African swine fever reaching pigs in the UK



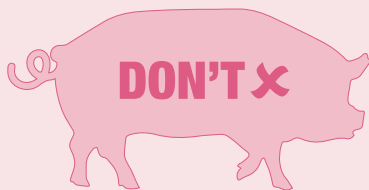
### Did you know?

African swine fever is present in Eastern Europe and Belgium and is spreading in Asia. It has led to the death of millions of pigs worldwide. It is highly contagious and fatal to pigs and if it reached the UK it would be devastating to our commercial pig industry, smallholders and pet pig keepers alike.

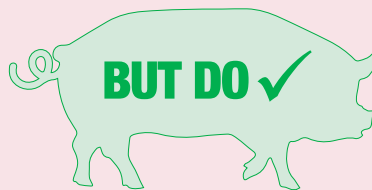
**It is illegal to feed pigs with catering waste or kitchen scraps as these can transmit African swine fever as well as other serious diseases such as foot and mouth disease and classical swine fever.**



### Feed your pigs the right food



- ✗ Feed food scraps and catering waste from any restaurant or commercial kitchen (including vegan kitchens).
- ✗ Feed domestic kitchen waste or scraps.
- ✗ Feed raw, partially cooked or fully cooked meat and fish (including shellfish).
- ✗ Feed dog and cat food.



- ✓ Feed specially formulated commercial pig feed as a safe and easy way to give your pigs a balanced diet.
- ✓ Feed fruit and vegetable material that has never entered a kitchen and which has not come into contact with material of animal origin.

### Practise good

#### biosecurity

- Use dedicated clothing and boots for you and anyone coming onto your premises.
- Prevent vehicles or equipment from coming on to your premises unless cleaned and disinfected first.
- Ensure that people who look after or visit your pigs understand the disease risk of bringing back meat products and in particular wild boar meat or pork/pork products from affected countries. Trade of pork from affected areas in these countries is illegal.
- Don't bring meat products onto the farm to avoid accidental access to pigs.

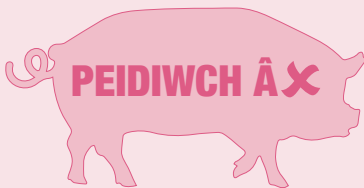
## Wyddech chi?

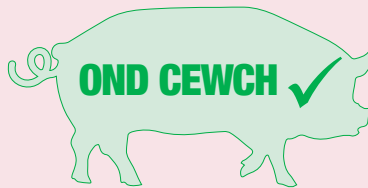

## Rhowch y bwydydd cywir i'ch moch



- ✗ Rhoi sbarion bwyd na gwastraff arlwyyo o unrhyw fwyty neu gegin fasnachol (gan gynnwys ceginau figan) gan fod hynny'n anghyfreithlon.
- ✗ Rhoi gwastraff neu sbarion o geginau domestig.
- ✗ Rhoi cigoedd a physgod amrwd, wedi'u coginio'n rhannol neu'n gyfan gwbl (gan gynnwys pysgod cregyn).
- ✗ Rhoi bwyd cŵn a chathod.



- ✓ Roi bwyd moch masnachol pwrpasol fel ffordd ddiogel a hawdd o roi deiet cytbwys i'ch moch.
- ✓ Roi deunydd ffrwythau a llysiau sydd erioed wedi bod mewn cegin ac sydd heb ddod i gyswllt â deunydd o darddiad anifail.

## Rhowch fesurau

### bioddiogelwch da ar waith

- Defnyddiwch ddillad ac esgidiau pwrpasol ar eich cyfer chi ac unrhyw un sy'n dod i'ch safle.
- Rhwystrwch gerbydau neu gyfarpar rhag dod i'ch safle oni bai eu bod wedi'u glanhau a'u diheintio.
- Gwnewch yn siŵr fod y bobl sy'n gofalu am eich moch neu'n ymweld â nhw yn deall y perygl o ledaenu'r clefyd drwy ddod â chynhyrchion cig ac yn benodol, gig baedd gwyllt neu borc/cynhyrchion porc yn ôl o wledydd sydd wedi'u heffeithio. Mae masnachu porc o ardaloedd sydd wedi'u heffeithio yn y gwledydd hynny yn anghyfreithlon.
- Peidiwch â dod â chynhyrchion cig i'r ffarm er mwyn osgoi cyswllt damweiniol â moch.access to pigs.
