Conditions of Issue

- 1. Isolation of animals in transit:
 - during movement, bovine animals travelling under this licence must not be allowed to come into contact with any other cattle except those being moved under a similar licence
 - where the movement is made by vehicle the cattle must not be unloaded (except in an emergency) until arrival at the premises specified overleaf.
- 2. Cleansing and disinfection of vehicles and vessels:
 - any road or rail vehicle or vessel used for conveying animals under this licence shall be cleansed and disinfected in the following manner as soon as possible after unloading and before the vehicle or vessel is used to transport livestock again:
 - the floor, roof and sides of the inside of the vehicle or vessel and all other parts with which such animals or any fodder, litter or any other matter may come into contact shall be scraped and swept and the scrapings and sweepings and all dung, sawdust, litter and other matter shall be effectually removed from contact with such animals
 - the same parts of the vehicle or vessel shall then be thoroughly washed or scrubbed with water, then disinfected by being thoroughly coated with a disinfected approved by the Department
 - after arrival at the premises specified the licensed animals shall not be permitted to come into contact with other bovine animals or deer on the premises until notice in writing has been given to the owner or person in charge of the animals by a Veterinary Inspector of the Department. They shall not be moved from the premises before such notice is given except under the authority and in accordance with the terms of the Licence granted by such an inspector or officer.
- 3. This licence is issued to the Keeper of the cattle being moved.
- 4. If during movement the licensed cattle are watered, the water shall be supplied in a clean bucket direct from a tap and not from a water trough. The bucket must then be disinfected.
- 5. The keeper of the animals remains responsible for ensuring that cattle presented to slaughter conform to the Meat Hygiene Service 'Clean Livestock Policy'. They should consult with the slaughterhouse of destination before consigning a dirty animal to slaughter.
- The movement of cattle pursuant to this Licence shall be entered in the record required to be kept under the Cattle Identification Regulations 2007 (as amended)/The Cattle Identification (Wales) Regulations 2007(as amended)/The Cattle Identification (Scotland) Regulations 2007 (as amended).
- 7. This licence may be cancelled at any time.
- 8. The person in charge of the animals being moved shall on demand by a Veterinary Inspector, an Officer of the Department or by an Inspector of the Local Authority or by a member of a police force furnish his/her name and address and shall produce a copy of this licence and allow it to be copied.
- The licence holder must report all cattle moved under this licence to British Cattle Movement Service (BCMS) for England and Wales or ScotEID for Scotland within three days of their movement or, if reporting to BCMS or ScotEID is not required, report all cattle moved to the local APHA office.
